Management Corner:



IS JUST AROUND THE CORNER

Hi All

I would like to thank the majority of the owners in the community for maintaining your homes and lots to a reasonable acceptable standard of care and maintenance. Unfortunately, there are still many owners that aren't meeting that standard and I am working on addressing

that by conducting monthly inspections and following up with rule violation warning letters, sometimes including fines and often telephone dialog to achieve rule compliance. The most sited violation that I write to about is in regards to lack of general lawn and flower bed maintenance. Each owner has the duty to maintain his/her lot to a reasonable standard and that is what I am attempting to pursue. It goes without saying that lawns and flower beds are going to need regular and consistent maintenance to be kept to the standard that the community deserves. My intent when writing to owners about rule violations is not to harass, but simply to get rule compliance. I try to be fair in making the assessment of a violation as well as to work with owners to achieve rule compliance.

Finances: We are doing great in tracking to budget and in dues collection. We are down to 33 owners on the delinquency report and a number of those owners are on agreed upon payment plans. Efforts are made to collect the dues and late fees are being charged to those that do not make payment arrangements. Liens are recorded against those that are non-responsive or do not follow through on payment plans.


All homeowners are encouraged to attend! Meetings occur the second Tuesday of each month at 7 p.m. in the Gateway Middle School Library unless otherwise noted.
